Waxing may cause bruises, scabs, scarring, redness, hyperpigmentation or pimples. Waxing of soft tissue may cause the skin to tear, resulting in the need for stitches. Complications occur most commonly in Brazilian bikini waxes, male or female.

New use of the products discussed increases the possibility of a reaction, so if started the aesthetician must be informed before the next waxing appointment starts.

Please Note:

Perfect waxing means that wax is applied and removed, and all of the hair comes off. You will have a smooth, stubble-free area that remains hairless between waxing appointments. This only occurs if the hair is long enough to be pulled out by the root. Tweezing prevents this from happening, and doesn't allow your hair to be a uniform length.

So, we ask that you be patient for about one month. Don't tweeze, shave, or use a depilatory cream. Come in every three to four weeks like clockwork, and you will love your waxing even more than you do now!
